Water and Sewer Line Protection: The water/sewer infrastructure is aging and with that can come issues with your service including damage to your pipes. Homeowners may want to keep an eye on their bill to monitor their charges for any irregularities. You may be interested to know that there is a protection and service plan offered through the provider by Homeserve. Look at your bill and find the information about Homeserve or go to www.MyHomeServeUSA.com. This service can cover repairs that you may face which otherwise might otherwise fall fully on you financially.

Proper Pet-iquette: When walking your dog, always carry a scooper or plastic bag to pick up your pet's waste and properly dispose of it. Abandoned pet waste is a neighborhood nuisance that can carry dangerous diseases into local creeks, rivers, lakes and the ocean.

No waste or waste bags should be allowed to lay on the common area anywhere in the community including the area between the Ridges and the Villas near the park.

Just a reminder, all pets must be on a leash when off of the pet owners property in The Ridges of Warrenton.

Spring Clean-Up, Wednesday, April 12

The Spring Clean-Up week is designed for residents to help with the removal and disposal of household items that may not be part of routine refuse pickup.

Town trucks will provide additional collections in all residential areas to pick up trash, refuse, and other items that cannot be handled during the regular weekly refuse schedule.

- o DO place items on the street line by **6 AM**.
- o DO place all trash/refuse in proper containers.
- o DO place tree limbs separately.
- o DO separate metal items from wood items.

DO be advised town crews cannot pick up tree trimmings and brush cut by tree companies and /or contractors; it is the responsibility of the Contractor/Landscaping Company doing the work to haul the brush/debris off.

For this collection, Town crews will pick up tires for a \$5.00 fee per tire (equal to County Landfill charges).

- O DO contact Public Works at (540) 347-1858 to arrange tire pickup and payment.
- o DO make sure tires are standard sized.

Any items they cannot currently accept

These items must be recycled at the landfill and there are fees to dispose of them. For more information on costs and when you can take any of the items listed to the landfill, call the Fauquier County Waste Management Office at (540) 422-8840. If any of these items are set out during Clean Up, they will not be picked up. If you have paint cans that are empty or dried up, remove the lid and set them out with your regular refuse collection. For more information, you may call the Public Works Department at (540) 347-1858.
