### Town of Warrenton—Fall Clean-Up

Fall Clean up for Ridges of Warrenton is Wednesday, October 23, 2019. Town trucks will provide extra collections in all residential areas to pick up trash, refuse and other items that cannot be handled on the regular weekly schedule. All items are to be placed on the street line by 8:00am. No return trips can be made. All trash and refuse must be placed in proper containers. Tree trimmings and brush must be placed separately. Small clippings from bushes or shrubs should be bagged and placed with regular refuse. The Town does not pick up any items containing Freon such as AC units, humidifiers, dehumidifiers, refrigerators, freezers, ect. The Town also does not pick up dirt, rocks, sod, stumps and large logs, concrete, blocks, bricks, slabs, masonry products, mattresses, box springs, TV's, computers, monitors, printers, copiers, fax machines, battery packs and any type of liquid, chemicals, antifreeze, or paint. ### Town of Warrenton—Leaf Collection

Leaf collection for The Ridges of Warrenton is scheduled for November 8th and (Monday Nov. 11 - Veteran's Day Holiday). All property owners are requested to rake leaves to the street line prior to 8:00am on the scheduled pick-up day. Do not rake leaves in ditch lines or gutters to prevent clogging. Locate leaves so that vehicles are not blocking them. Do not put brush, limbs, rocks or other debris with leaves and do not rake leaves out more than one week early. There will be a second leaf collection December 6 & 9. After completion of the second collection, there will be limited collection up through January 3, 2020, after which time any remaining leaves will have to be bagged and set out with household refuse. NO LEAF COLLECTION AFTER JANUARY 3, 2020.
