Instructions, Conditions and Requirements

- 1. Applications must be submitted with detailed plans, elevations and specifications of the project to be retained with the ACC files. Applications for construction must include a copy of the lot survey plat. All materials used must be clearly specified in the description, or listed on the drawings provided with the application.
- 2. Approval of any project by the ACC does not waive the homeowners' responsibility for obtaining the appropriate Fauquier County permits and inspections that may be required. Further, obtaining the appropriate Fauquier county permit does not waive the requirements of the ACC approval.
- 3. It is incumbent upon the homeowner not to build on common ground, buffer zones, or easements (public or private). The Lot owner will not hold the ACC, the Board of Directors, The Association or its Management Agent responsible for the Lot Owner or his contractor digging or building on an easement, buffer zone, common ground, or another Lot owner's property. It is the sole responsibility of the Lot owners to locate all in ground utilities prior to or allowing his contractor to dig. Cal Miss Utility at least (72) hours prior to digging at 1-800-257-7777 in order to locate such utilities.
- 4. The Lot owner is directly responsible for any drainage problems resulting from construction on their Lot.
- 5. The Lot owner is responsible for correcting any damage caused as a result of their work to the common grounds or neighboring properties.
- 6. Exterior color changes must fall within the color-scheme of the community. Dried paint on the house must match the samples provided with this application.
- 7. For approved applications, the ACC will issue an approval form specifying parameters and conditions for the project. This form should be kept with the homeowners' papers and provided to succeeding owners.
- 8. Should your application be denied you will be provided with specific points of contention. You may request a meeting in person with the ACC to review issues. If the ACC decision remains unchanged, you are entitled to, and may request, a hearing with the Board of directors.
